- F1, Matures in 85 days
 - Vine
 - Produces juicy red beefsteak tomatoes
 - Excellent rich hearty flavour



- TM781A Sweet Million Tomato**
- F1, matures in 60-62 days
 - Vine
 - Cherry tomato seeds are easy to grow, and hardy plants adapt well to many climates
 - Winner of the Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) Award of Garden Merit



- TM784A Amish Paste**
- OP, Matures in 70-75 days
 - Vine
 - Heirloom roma tomato that produces heavy yields of fruit
 - Deep red flesh that is nearly seedless



- TM786A Sungold Cherry Tomato**
- F1, 65 days
 - Vine
 - Incredible tropical fruit flavour
 - Long, very productive vines

 - Deadhead regularly to prolong the bloom



- FL3141A Iceland Poppies**
- Perennial
 - Delicate bright hardy Iceland poppy with apricot, gold, tangerine and white flowers
 - Deer Resistant



- FL3141A Patio Mix Sweet Pea**
- Perennial
 - Delicate bright hardy poppy with apricot, gold, tangerine and white flowers
 - Deer Resistant



- FL3265A Peredovick**
- Annual
 - Heirloom cultivar that grows to 1.5-2m (5-6') with a single flower
 - Great for pollinators. Produces black oil seeds, good for birds



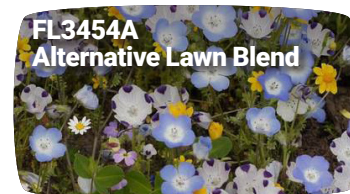
- FL3267A Music Box Sunflower**
- Uniform dwarf sunflowers are perfect in large containers on the patio
 - Produce showy 10-13cm (4-5") wide flowers

 - Highly attractive to hummingbirds



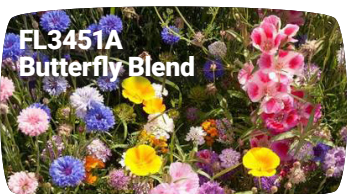
- FL3454A Alternative Lawn Blend**

 - Works well in containers or raised beds

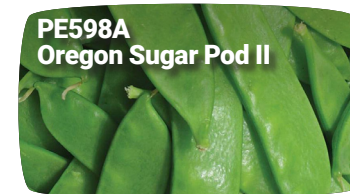

- OP, matures in 70 days
 - Mini romaine head 15cm (6") tall, great for containers
 - RHS Award of Garden Merit

Tom Thumb**
- OP, matures in 50 - 70 days
 - Small Heirloom butterhead lettuce
 - Great for containers

Three Week Blend**
- Harvest in 3 weeks
 - A colourful blend with lots of flavour
