

Subject Title: Why buy a wristband for the Spring Fair?

A Message from your Spring Fair Coordinator:

Dear Parents,

I wanted to follow up with a more detailed description regarding the Spring Fair Wristbands, as we have been getting lots of questions regarding them.

They are similar to a “ride wristband” at the Saanich fair but for the games. The kids with wristbands will have unlimited access to all the games and activities (except the guessing game as that is licensed separately and put on by the Canadian Parents for French). If you purchase a wristband for your child there will be no need for tickets to play the games, go on bouncy castles and slides, have face painted, tattoo, hair done etc. It will be a one shot purchase.

You will also be able to use the more traditional ticket system for all other games and activities. All tickets will be \$1 and all the games and activities range between 1-3 tickets. If you are intending on being at the fair for 2-4 hours and have your children partake in all the games and activities, possibly several times, it would not be hard to play or partake in more than \$25 worth of activities (some kids my want to go on the inflatable 20+ times –lol). If you’re intention is just to stop by check it out for an hour or so and just do a few of the activities or games then tickets might be the better way to go.

If you want to save a bit of \$\$\$ then we suggest pre- buying your wristbands this week to save \$5 per wristband. If you’re undecided and want to wait, you will still be able to purchase a wristband All games and activities and the rest of the month and even at the door just like the Saanich Fair and it will still be better value than individual tickets if you plan to spend the day at the fair.

I hope this helps clarify any confusion about the Fair and Wristbands
